You Tube

If children want to set up a YT channel make sure they use a parents account.

Make the YT channel private rather than public.

For younger children, download YOU TUBE KIDS. You Tube is extremely popular with many children. Vloggers such as DanTDM and Ali-A have become incredibly popular with primary aged children.

In addition, young children like watching You Tube to see episodes of their favourite cartoons. Here are some parental tips:

- In order to see what your child is sharing and viewing, set up a FAMILY ACCOUNT. You will need a Google username and password to do this.
- Put on the SAFETY CONTROLS by going down to the bottom of the page and clicking 'on' for Safety Mode.
- Due to the auto roll feature on You Tube, children can type in the search area, watch a video and then see an inappropriate video which is next on the list. By clicking SUBSCRIBE on their child's favourite channel, they can view more appropriate videos.
- If a child wants to UPLOAD a video to You Tube, make sure that it is either PRIVATE or UNLISTED which means that only friends and those with a link can watch it.
