We are excited to announce that as part of our learning for this term, children in F1 (Nursery) and F2T will be visited by Sam's Safaris on Monday 13th May 2024.

Sam's Safaris was founded in 2002 with the goal to educate by allowing both children and adults the chance to get first-hand experience, and have hands-on encounters with different species of animals. Their mission is to educate about the natural behaviour, biology, habitats and diets of exotic species, raise awareness of wildlife conservation and give everyone the chance to interact with animals that they may have never had the chance to see before.

Children will have the opportunity to meet and interact with rare and exotic invertebrates, reptiles, amphibians, birds and mammals from around the world.

The workshop will take place within school during normal school hours, and each class will spend approximately one hour learning about and interacting with the animals. The cost of the experience is £5.05, this is to be paid on ParentPay by Friday 26th April 2024.
