Traffic Enforcement

Dear Parents and Carers,

As a school, the safety of our pupils is our number one priority. Over the past 2 years, there have been an increasing number of accidents and near misses on Jossey Lane outside Castle Hills. One contributing factor to this increase is the disregard for road markings when parking at drop-off and pick-up times. Cars are regularly parking over the yellow zigzag lines and in the bus stop, meaning that children and parents have very little visibility when crossing the road. This is also the case at the top of the drive where cars regularly park over the white lines meaning that staff and visitors leaving the school have to pull out and turn blindly onto Jossey Lane.

We have been in regular communication with both South Yorkshire Police and the Traffic Enforcement Department at Doncaster Council. Moving forward, they have agreed that school is able to take photographs of cars and their registrations if parked illegally and send these to their teams. Where appropriate, fines will be handed out.

We thank you for your support in this matter and hope that the above is a sufficient deterrent leading to increased safety for our community.
