What does this experience offer?

Young Voices National and International Choir Experience provides children with the opportunity to perform in some of the world's greatest arenas alongside incredible artists and has a massive impact on the children involved. Furthermore, to achieve this with all their school friends around them for support, helps their self-belief, confidence and ability to communicate as part of a team, which is invaluable. Add to this the numerous health benefits of consistent singing in rehearsals, from breathing regulation to relieving stress and it's no wonder that Young Voices is over-subscribed year after year.
