Year 6 Residential visit to Alton Towers 2026

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are pleased to inform you that Castle Hills is planning a thrilling and educational trip to Alton Towers Resort and theme park, Splash Landings waterpark and Warwick Castle. The trip will take place from Wednesday 24th June to Friday 26th June 2026. We believe this trip will provide our Year 6 pupils with an enjoyable and lasting memory.

The trip will include a 2 night stay at the Alton Towers Splash Landings Hotel, ensuring that the students have ample time to explore the park and make the most of their visit. Alton Towers is one of the UK's most popular and thrilling theme parks. It offers a diverse range of attractions, including exhilarating rides, live shows, and interactive experiences. Additionally, Splash Landings is a fantastic waterpark that guarantees hours of water-based fun for all students. On the final day we will travel to the historic town of Warwick for pupils to visit Warwick Castle. With over 1,100 years of history, the castle has witnessed some of the most significant events in British history, from the Battle of Hastings to the imprisonment of Joan of Arc, we're sure there will be lots for our pupils to discover.

The approximate cost for the visit will be £300 (depending on pupil numbers) which will cover transport by coach, accommodation, meals, entrance fees and spending money. Payment will consist of a non-refundable £50 deposit with the remaining balance being spread evenly on ParentPay. An adjustment will be made once the final cost is known.

Throughout the trip, our dedicated team of staff members will ensure that your child is well supervised and supported. We have carefully appointed a team of experienced teachers and support staff who will be responsible for the smooth running of the trip.

Please pay your deposit on ParentPay by the deadline of 24th October to secure your child's place on this exciting opportunity.

Please note; as with all school trips, your child's participation will depend on behaviour throughout the year. If your child is unable to attend due to behaviour related issues, then no monies will be refunded.
